AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21510(d) OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE
PURCHASE OF LIQUID FUELS BY THE GUAM
POWER AUTHORITY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 21510(d) of the Government Code
3 of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(d) The provisions requiring contracts, bids
5 or notices shall not apply to the procurement of
6 professional or technical services, nor to the pro-
7 curement of replacement parts required by the
8 Authority, nor to the procurement of liquid fuels for
9 electric power generation; provided, that in the case
10 of procurement of liquid fuels only, the procurement
11 process shall be governed by the following:

12 (1) Proposals shall be publicly solicited
13 from the maximum number of qualified sources
14 consistent with the nature and requirements of the
15 fuels to be procured;

16 (2) Written or oral discussions shall be
17 publicly conducted by the Board with all responsible
18 offerors who submit proposals within a competitive
19 range on price and any other considerations the
20 Board deems appropriate. Award shall be published
21 in a newspaper of general circulation in Guam within
22 ten (10) days of such award."
