AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21510(d) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE PURCHASE OF LIQUID FUELS BY THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 21510(d) of the Government Code

of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

- "(d) The provisions requiring contracts, bids or notices shall not apply to the procurement of professional or technical services, nor to the procurement of replacement parts required by the Authority, nor to the procurement of liquid fuels for electric power generation; provided, that in the case of procurement of liquid fuels only, the procurement process shall be governed by the following:
  - (1) Proposals shall be publicly solicited from the maximum number of qualified sources consistent with the nature and requirements of the fuels to be procured;
  - publicly conducted by the Board with all responsible offerors who submit proposals within a competitive range on price and any other considerations the Board deems appropriate. Award shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Guam within ten (10) days of such award."
