AN ACT TO EXEMPT PERSONS OVER THE AGE OF 60 FROM TUITION AND FEES PAYMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. A new Subsection (4) is hereby added to Section 11837 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"(4). Persons of the age of 60 shall not be charged tuition or fees for attendance during their freshman, sophomore, junior and senior years at the University; provided that such individuals meet the admission requirements of the University of Guam and of full time student status."

11 Section 2. A new Section 11832.1 is added to the 12 Government Code of Guam to read:

"Section 11332.1. Same: Student Member. Unless a member already so qualifies, the first vacancy occurring on the Board of Regents for whatever reason after the effective date of this Section shall be filled by a Student Member. Future appointments to fill vacancies shall be made so as to assure that the membership of the Board will include at least one (1) Student Member."
