AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 55003.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO CONFINEMENT OF PERSONS CHARGED WITH CRIMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 55003.1 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section S5003.1. In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction finds that facilities used to detain persons charged with crimes are inadequate, the Director is hereby authorized to hold such persons in custody, provided, however, that the Director detain such persons in an area separate and apart from those persons who have been convicted of a crime and are serving sentences of imprisonment."

Section 2. Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Director is hereby authorized to expend,

commit, encumber, or otherwise obligate funds for the purpose of complying with Section 1 of this Act, provided, however, that the Director file with the Speaker of the Legislature within thirty (30) days following the date of said expenditure or encumbrance a report setting forth the reasons for and the amounts of any expenditure or encumbrance.
