
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4104 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE
FOR A TWO-STEP PAY INCREASE UPON
PROMOTION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4104 is hereby amended to read as

3 follows:

4 "Section 4104. Step increases. The step
5 increases within the pay ranges provided for in the
6 Pay Range Schedule fixed by Section 4103 of this
7 Chapter shall be made in accordance with applicable
8 rules and regulations; provided that employees who
9 are promoted to a higher pay range shall receive a
10 salary which is not less than the equivalent of a
11 two-step pay increase in the pay range held prior to
12 promotion. Step 10 shall be the maximum step for
13 any step increase upon promotion."
