AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 653b OF THE  
PENAL CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE  
PUNISHMENT FOR THE SOLICITATION OF  
THE COMMISSION OF A CRIME.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 653b of the Penal Code of Guam  
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 653b. Solicitation commission of a  
5 crime. Punishment. Proof. Every person who solicits  
6 another to offer to accept or join in the offer or  
7 acceptance of a bribe, or to commit or join in the  
8 commission of murder, robbery, burglary, grand theft,  
9 receiving stolen property, extortion, rape by force  
10 and violence, perjury, subornation of perjury, forgery,  
11 or kidnapping, is punishable by imprisonment for not  
12 less than one (1) year nor more than five (5) years  
13 or by fine of not more than Five Thousand Dollars  
14 (\$5,000.00). Such offense must be proven by the  
15 testimony of two (2) witnesses, or of one (1) witness  
16 and corroborating circumstances."
