


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by B. M. Palomo

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13501(a) OF PUBLIC
LAW 12-226, TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE,
RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE CHAMORRO LAND
TRUST COMMISSION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13501(a) of Public Law 12-226,
3 Twelfth Guam Legislature is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(a). There is within the Government of Guam the
5 Chamorro Land Trust Commission. The Commission shall
6 be composed of five (5) members to be appointed by the
7 Governor with the confirmation of the Legislature.
8 Commission members shall be appointed within (60) days
9 after the enactment of this Chapter. All members shall
10 have been residents of the territory at least three
11 (3) years prior to their appointment and at least
12 three (3) of the members shall be native Chamorro.
13 Members shall serve terms of three (3) years, provided,
14 however, that of the members first appointed, one (1)
15 shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year and two
16 (2) shall be appointed for terms of two (2) years.
17 The members of the Commission shall serve without pay,
18 but shall receive reimbursement for actual expenses
19 incurred by them in the discharge of their duties as
20 such members. The Governor shall appoint the Chairman
21 of the Commission from among the members thereof. The
22 Commission shall have its first meeting within twenty
23 (20) days after confirmation of its members."
