




Introduced by A. C. Ysrael

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11120 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE FOR SCHOOL
BOARD POLICIES RELATIVE TO STUDENT
ACTIVITY FUNDS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11120 is added to the Government Code
3 to read:

4 "Section 11120. The Territorial Board of Education
5 shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary to
6 regulate conduct of fund raising activities on the part
7 of students, to safeguard the funds raised by such
8 activities, and for the audit of such funds. Said rules
9 and regulations shall include but need not be limited
10 to the following:

11 (1) The educational, recreational or cultural
12 rationale necessary to justify the holding of any
13 particular class or school activity.

14 (2) Regulations governing qualifications of
15 firms or persons who may do business with school
16 classes or activities.

17 (3) Regulations governing selection of school
18 personnel who may act in an official or unofficial
19 capacity for students.

20 (4) Regulations requiring that sound business
21 practices be used in the conduct of any school or
22 class activity.

1 (5) All purchase contracts between vendors and
2 class activities, sponsors or school principal
3 shall be subject to Board approval.

4 (6) No agreement relative to school or class
5 activity shall exceed one (1) year in duration.

6 (7) A requirement that an annual audit of all
7 school and class activity funds be performed and a
8 report filed with the Board and the Legislature."
