

Introduced by A. C. Ysrael

AN ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 11120, 11120.1,
11120.2 AND 11120.3 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE TO PROVIDE FOR A PROGRAM OF STUDIES
FOR GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENTS AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Sections 11120, 11120.1, 11120.2 and 11120.3
3 are added to the Government Code to read:

4 "Section 11120. The Board of Education shall
5 develop a program of studies that will provide for the
6 development of the unusual and special abilities of
7 gifted students enrolled in the schools of Guam. For
8 the purposes of this Act, 'gifted students' shall
9 mean students who exhibit leadership ability,
10 artistic talent, creativity, outstanding academic
11 ability and high intelligence.

12 Section 11120.1. The Board shall cause to be
13 conducted an assessment to identify gifted students
14 within the schools of Guam.

15 Section 11120.2. The Board shall cause to be
16 conducted a periodic assessment of the progress of the
17 students in the gifted students program and the results
18 of said assessment are to be used to determine whether
19 the program should be modified.

20 Section 11120.3. The Board shall provide for
21 in-service training for teachers necessary to conduct
22 the program established by Section 11120."
