

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



Introduced by A. C. Ysrael

AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 11116 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE REQUIRING THE BOARD OF
EDUCATION TO DESIGN, DEVELOP AND IMPLE-
MENT A CRIME PREVENTION AND DRUG ABUSE
EDUCATION PROGRAM IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

1 Statement of Legislative Finding: Because of the
2 complexity of the motives which underlie acts of juvenile
3 crime and drug abuse, it is desirable that all students in
4 grades kindergarten through twelve be involved in a well
5 planned sequential program designed to combat juvenile
6 delinquency and drug abuse.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 1. A new Section 11116 is hereby added to the
9 Government Code to read as follows:

10 "Section 11116. The Board shall develop a crime
11 prevention and drug abuse education program for all
12 students in the public schools of Guam taking into
13 consideration the age and grade level of the students
14 involved. The primary objective of the program shall
15 be to combat juvenile crime and drug abuse. The
16 Board shall cause to be developed a curriculum consis-
17 tent with the objectives of this program. Said
18 curriculum shall take into consideration the concepts
19 of human growth and development, values clarification,
20 citizenship, physical and mental health, personal
21 and social relationships, and use of leisure time.

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The Board shall cause to be conducted both preservice and in-service teacher training programs which shall provide for the effective implementation of the program. The Board shall also provide consultive services to the individual schools within the Department of Education through the use of coordinators."
