




AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER III TO  
TITLE VI TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE  
RELATIVE TO ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL  
GRANTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter III is added to Title VI of the  
3 Government Code to read as follows:

4 "CHAPTER III

5 Acceptance of Federal Grants

6 Section 5200. Prohibition. Except as herein other-  
7 wise provided, no governmental program or activity shall  
8 be undertaken unless it shall be funded by moneys appro-  
9 priated by the Guam Legislature.

10 Section 5201. Federal funds may be used for the  
11 operation of a government program and activity, provided  
12 that the Legislature, by resolution, shall first give its  
13 approval to said program or activity.

14 Section 5202. Notwithstanding Sections 5200 and  
15 5201 of this Act, any governmental program or activity  
16 that involves one hundred percentum (100%) federal funds,  
17 on-going programs or activities, and/or programs or  
18 activities previously approved by the Guam Legislature  
19 by resolution, shall not be covered by the prohibitions  
20 imposed in this Act."
