Bill No. 414

Introduced by B. V.D. Ada

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER III TO TITLE VI TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL GRANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Chapter III is added to Title VI of the Government Code to read as follows:

## "CHAPTER III

## Acceptance of Federal Grants

Section 5200. Prohibition. Except as herein otherwise provided, no governmental program or activity shall be undertaken unless it shall be funded by moneys appropriated by the Guam Legislature.

Section 5201. Federal funds may be used for the operation of a government program and activity, provided that the Legislature, by resolution, shall first give its approval to said program or activity.

Section 5202. Notwithstanding Sections 5200 and 5201 of this Act, any governmental program or activity that involves one hundred percentum (100%) federal funds, on-going programs or activities, and/or programs or activities previously approved by the Guam Legislature by resolution, shall not be covered by the prohibitions imposed in this Act."
