AN ACT TO AMEND THE TITLE TO CHAPTER I, TITLE VI, GOVERNMENT CODE; TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 5000 AND ADD A NEW SECTION 5001, TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE, RELATIVE TO FILLING THE VACANCIES CAUSED BY THE TEMPORARY ABSENCE OF THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR AND THE SPEAKER OR PERMANENT ABSENCES OF THE GOVERNOR AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The Title to Chapter I, Title VI, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"CHAPTER I

Office of the Governor"

Section 2. Section 5000 of the Government Code is hereby repealed and a new Section 5000 is enacted to read:

"Section 5000. Temporary vacancies, order of succession. (a) The order of succession, consisting of three (3) officers of the Executive Branch who shall be eligible in the order named, to serve as Acting Governor upon the temporary disability or temporary absence of both the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor shall be the Director of Administration, the Director of Budget and Management and the Attorney General. While serving as Acting Governor a person so authorized shall have all the powers of the Governor.

(b) The order of succession, consisting of three (3) officers of the Executive Branch who shall be eligible in the order named, to serve as Acting Lieutenant Governor upon the temporary disability or temporary

absence of the Governor or the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of the Guam Legislature shall be the Director of Administration, the Director of Budget and Management and the Attorney General. While serving as Acting Lieutenant Governor a person so authorized shall have all the powers of the Lieutenant Governor."

Section 3. A new Section 5001 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 5001. Permanent vacancies. (a) In case of a permanent vacancy in the offices of both the Governor and Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the Guam Legislature shall upon his resignation as Speaker become the Governor, to hold office for the unexpired term and until he or his successor shall have been duly elected and qualified at the next regular election for Governor.

- (b) If by reason of death, resignation, removal from office, inability or failure to qualify, there is no Speaker to act as Governor under Subsection (a) of this Section, then the Director of the Department highest on the Order of Succession established by Section 5000 (a) and (b) of this Act who is not under disability to discharge the powers and duties of the Office of the Governor shall become Governor. An individual who becomes Governor under this Subsection shall continue to serve until the expiration of the then current term of the Governor. The taking of the oath of office by an individual under this Subsection shall constitute his resignation from the office upon which his succession is based.
 - (c) During the period that an individual serves as Governor under this Section, his compensation shall be the same as that then provided by law for the Governor."
