




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Substitute Bill No. 499, "An Act to amend Section 62012 A to increase the membership of the Central Planning Council, to repeal and reenact Section 62015, to add Sections 62015.1 and 62015.2, to amend Sections 62016, 62017, and 62019 and to repeal Sections 13205, 13206, 13207, 13208, and 13250 of the Government Code of Guam relative to withdrawing from the Territorial Planning Commission its functions concerning the Development of a Comprehensive Plan for Guam and to requiring legislative consent to the Director of the Bureau of Planning, and for other purposes", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on October 30, 1975, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 5th day of November, 1975, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 18 members.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 62012 A TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE CENTRAL PLANNING COUNCIL, TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 62015, TO ADD SECTIONS 62015.1 AND 62015.2, TO AMEND SECTIONS 62016, 62017, AND 62019 AND TO REPEAL SECTIONS 13205, 13206, 13207, 13208, AND 13250 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO WITHDRAWING FROM THE TERRITORIAL PLANNING COMMISSION ITS FUNCTIONS CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR GUAM AND TO REQUIRING LEGISLATIVE CONSENT TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE BUREAU OF PLANNING, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 62012 A of the Government Code of  
3 Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "A. Central Planning Council. Creation and  
5 membership. There is created in the Government Code of  
6 Guam a Central Planning Council (hereinafter referred to  
7 as 'Council'), consisting of eleven (11) members con-  
8 sisting of the members of the Territorial Planning  
9 Commission, two (2) to be appointed by the Governor  
10 from the heads of departments or agencies of the Govern-  
11 ment of Guam and two (2) to be appointed by the Speaker  
12 from among private citizens. The Attorney General or  
13 his authorized designee shall act as legal counsel to  
14 the Council."

1           Section 2. Section 62015 of the Government Code of Guam  
2 is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

3           "Section 62015. Plan review: public hearings.  
4 Comprehensive Plan elements, prepared by the various  
5 public agencies, shall be submitted to the Council for  
6 review. Within forty-five (45) days following receipt of  
7 any such element or elements by the Council, the Council  
8 shall hold one or more public hearings thereon. Announce-  
9 ments of such hearings shall be placed in a newspaper of  
10 general circulation on Guam ten (10) days and one (1)  
11 day prior thereto. Summaries of the element or elements  
12 to be heard shall be prepared by the BP and submitted to  
13 appropriate news or other media."

14           Section 3. A new Section 62015.1 is hereby added to the  
15 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

16           "Section 62015.1. Plan submission. Within fifteen  
17 (15) days after the hearing of a plan element or elements,  
18 the Council shall submit to the Governor its recommenda-  
19 tion thereon including a summary of testimony at the  
20 hearing."

21           Section 4. A new Section 62015.2 is hereby added to the  
22 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

23           "Section 62015.2. Cooperation of other departments.  
24 Every department and agency of the Government of Guam  
25 is hereby directed to render such assistance to the  
26 Council as the Council may require."

27           Section 5. Section 62016 of the Government Code of Guam  
28 is hereby amended to read as follows:

29           "Section 62016. Plan adoption. Comprehensive Plan  
30 elements received by the Governor from the Council may  
31 be approved, disapproved or referred to the Council for

1 further recommendation prior to approval. Following  
2 approval by the Governor, Plan elements shall be sub-  
3 mitted to the Guam Legislature for adoption by resolu-  
4 tion."

5 Section 6. Section 62017 of the Government Code of Guam  
6 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 "Section 62017. Bureau of Planning. There is  
8 created within the Office of the Governor, the Bureau  
9 of Planning, (hereinafter referred to as 'BP') to serve  
10 as staff for the Council and to administer central  
11 planning functions. The director BP will carry the  
12 Title 'Director of Planning' and shall be appointed by  
13 the Governor with the consent of the Legislature. He  
14 Shall be a person who as a result of his training, experi-  
15 ence, and attainments is exceptionally well qualified to  
16 analyze and interpret development trends and information  
17 of all kinds, to appraise and coordinate planning programs  
18 and supervise the execution of the responsibilities of  
19 the Council in accordance with the policies set forth  
20 in this Chapter. The Director's salary shall be as  
21 provided by Section 4106 of the Government Code of  
22 Guam. He shall be responsible for the administration of  
23 this Chapter and shall supervise the BP staff which, in  
24 addition to its regular duties, shall serve the Council."

25 Section 7. Subsection F of Section 62019 of the Govern-  
26 ment Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

27 "F. to submit the plan to the Council for public  
28 hearings as provided in this Chapter;"

29 Section 3. Sections 13205, 13206, 13207, 13208, and  
30 13250 of the Government Code of Guam are hereby repealed in  
31 their entireties.

Section 9. Section 4106 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended by adding the following:

"Director of Planning 1 \$26,000"

Section 10. Section 9 of this Act shall become effective only upon the implementation of Section 1 of Public Law 12-197.
