

Introduced by Committee on Rules

AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 102.1 AND 102.2  
TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO  
DELINEATING MUNICIPALITY BOUNDARIES, AND  
RELATED MATTERS.

1 WHEREAS, there is considerable confusion in the minds of  
2 many local residents as to the municipality in which they  
3 officially live; and

4 WHEREAS, real estate tax, water, power and telephone bills  
5 frequently bear different municipality name from that of the  
6 area in which residents apparently live; and

7 WHEREAS, in case of emergencies, it is very difficult  
8 because of this confusion to determine the location of a  
9 specific residence or piece of property; now, therefore

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11 Section 1. Sections 102.1 and 102.2 of Title I, Chapter I,  
12 are hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as  
13 follows:

14 "Section 102.1. Municipalities. Municipal boundaries,  
15 delineated as area descriptions in Section 15001.1 of the  
16 Government Code are the official boundaries of the various  
17 municipalities on Guam.

18 Section 102.2. Property within municipalities. The  
19 Director of Land Management shall immediately redesignate  
20 such property within the Territory which is not in con-  
21 formance with the municipality listing in Section 102.1  
22 above, and all governmental agencies shall adjust their  
23 records to comply with such new property designations."
