

Public Law 13-93
Thirteenth Guam Legislature
(Bill 522)

AN ACT

An Act to amend Sections 61006, 61007, 61009, 61013(b), 61015 and 61016 of the Government Code relative to the Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 61006 of the Government Code (Public Law 12-194) is amended to read:

"Section 61006. Station Manager of the Facility. Subject to the advice and consent of the Legislature the Governor of Guam, upon the recommendation of the Board, shall appoint a Station Manager of the facility who shall be responsible to the Board for the day to day operation of the corporation and shall administer its programs, policies and the facility used for and in the production and transmission of the corporation's programs. The Station Manager shall serve a fixed term as specified by the Board, or until his successor has been appointed and qualified. The Board shall fix policy and procedure applicable if the Station Manager is unable, for any reason, to complete his term. The Station Manager shall not participate in any decision of the Board relative to the fixing of his term, his salary, nor on any matter affecting his tenure in office, nor shall he vote thereon."

Section 2. Section 61007 of the Government Code (Public Law 12-194) is amended to read:

"Section 61007. Salary and Expenses. The Station Manager shall be paid a salary and such other allowances and emoluments as the Board may approve. The salaries of the other employees of the Corporation shall be determined by the Board upon the recommendation of the Station Manager in accordance with the provisions of Title V of the Government Code of Guam."

Section 3. Section 61009 of the Government Code (Public Law 12-194) is amended to read:

"Section 61009. Board, misc. Provisions. (a) The Board shall be responsible for the management, administration, policies and direction of the Corporation and shall exercise supervision through the Station Manager.

(b) The Board shall meet in regular session at least once each month, commencing during the fourth month following the enactment of this Act, and in special session as often as it may deem necessary. Meetings of the Board shall be open, except for matters pertaining to the hiring and dismissal of any employee or Station Manager of the Corporation.

(c) A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The Board shall act by a vote of at least four (4) of its members.

(d) The Board members shall receive no salary for their services on the Board, provided, however, that they may be paid a reasonable per diem not to exceed Twenty Dollars (\$20) for attendance at meetings of the Board and reasonable travel allowance for time spent on official business of the Corporation, except that the Station Manager shall not be paid any sums under this clause."

Section 4. Section 61013 of the Government Code (Public Law 12-194) is amended to read:

"Section 61013. Guam Education Telecommunications Facility. (a) The Facility shall consist of the production and broadcasting equipment necessary to artistically produce and project television programs. It shall be staffed by responsible professional and technical employees whose combined efforts will result in meaningful and entertaining television fare.

(b) The Facility shall be organized under the Station Manager.

(c) It shall consistently strive to stay abreast of the state of the art and maintain the highest possible levels of programming, concept design and production. It shall study and recommend to the Corporation such expansion, modification, extension or other change necessary to serve its stated goals and to best serve the needs of all of the people of Guam."

Section 5. Section 61015 of the Government Code (Public Law 12-194) is amended to read:

"Section 61015. Use and design of the Facility. The Facility, under the Station Manager, shall be responsible for carrying out the purposes of the Corporation as provided by law and as directed by the Board of Trustees. The Station Manager shall establish such divisions as he deems necessary for the proper operation of the Facility, including but not limited to Administration, Programming, Production and Engineering. Each division shall undertake the tasks and functions assigned to it by the Station Manager."

Section 6. Section 61016 of the Government Code (Public Law 12-194) is amended to read:

"Section 61016. Employees. (a) The Station Manager shall establish, after approval of the Board, the conditions of entry to, maintenance in and dismissal from employment in the Corporation not in conflict with the provisions of the Civil Service Commission. Employees shall be provided Workmen's Compensation coverage, Health Insurance, and shall be members of the Guam Retirement Fund, provided that contract employees shall not be members of the Guam Retirement Fund.


(b) The Station Manager shall be responsible for recruitment of all employees of the Corporation."





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 61006, 61007,
61009, 61013(b), 61015 AND 61016 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO THE GUAM
EDUCATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 61006 of the Government Code (Public
3 Law 12-194) is amended to read:

4 "Section 61006. Station Manager of the Facility.
5 Subject to the advice and consent of the Legislature the
6 Governor of Guam, upon the recommendation of the Board,
7 shall appoint a Station Manager of the facility who shall
8 be responsible to the Board for the day to day operation
9 of the corporation and shall administer its programs,
10 policies and the facility used for and in the production
11 and transmission of the corporation's programs. The
12 Station Manager shall serve a fixed term as specified
13 by the Board, or until his successor has been appointed
14 and qualified. The Board shall fix policy and procedure
15 applicable if the Station Manager is unable, for any
16 reason, to complete his term. The Station Manager shall
17 not participate in any decision of the Board relative to
18 the fixing of his term, his salary, nor on any matter
19 affecting his tenure in office, nor shall he vote thereon."

20 Section 2. Section 61007 of the Government Code (Public
21 Law 12-194) is amended to read:

1 "Section 61007.. Salary and Expenses. The Station
2 Manager shall be paid a salary and such other
3 allowances and emoluments as the Board may approve. The
4 salaries of the other employees of the Corporation shall
5 be determined by the Board upon the recommendation of the
6 Station Manager in accordance with the provisions of
7 Title V of the Government Code of Guam."

8 Section 3. Section 61009 of the Government Code (Public
9 Law 12-194) is amended to read:

10 "Section 61009. Board, misc. Provisions. (a) The
11 Board shall be responsible for the management, administra-
12 tion, policies and direction of the Corporation and shall
13 exercise supervision through the Station Manager.

14 (b) The Board shall meet in regular session at least
15 once each month, commencing during the fourth month
16 following the enactment of this Act, and in special session
17 as often as it may deem necessary. Meetings of the Board
18 shall be open, except for matters pertaining to the hiring
19 and dismissal of any employee or Station Manager of the
20 Corporation.

21 (c) A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum
22 for the transaction of business. The Board shall act by a
23 vote of at least four (4) of its members.

24 (d) The Board members shall receive no salary for

2 Law 12-194) is amended to read:

3 "Section 61013. Guam Education Telecommunications
4 Facility. (a) The Facility shall consist of the produc-
5 tion and broadcasting equipment necessary to artistically
6 produce and project television programs. It shall be
7 staffed by responsible professional and technical employees
8 whose combined efforts will result in meaningful and
9 entertaining television fare.

10 (b) The Facility shall be organized under the
11 Station Manager.

12 (c) It shall consistently strive to stay abreast of
13 the state of the art and maintain the highest possible
14 levels of programming, concept design and production. It
15 shall study and recommend to the Corporation such expan-
16 sion, modification, extension or other change necessary to
17 serve its stated goals and to best serve the needs of all
18 of the people of Guam."

19 Section 5. Section 61015 of the Government Code (Public
20 Law 12-194) is amended to read:

21 "Section 61015. Use and design of the Facility. The
22 Facility, under the Station Manager, shall be responsible
23 for carrying out the purposes of the Corporation as
24 provided by law and as directed by the Board of Trustees.
25 The Station Manager shall establish such divisions as he
26 deems necessary for the proper operation of the Facility,
27 including but not limited to Administration, Programming,
28 Production and Engineering. Each division shall
29 undertake the tasks and functions assigned to it by the
30 Station Manager."

1 Section 6. Section 61016 of the Government Code (Public
2 Law 12-194) is amended to read:

3 "Section 61016. Employees. (a) The Station
4 Manager shall establish, after approval of the Board, the
5 conditions of entry to, maintenance in and dismissal from
6 employment in the Corporation not in conflict with the
7 provisions of the Civil Service Commission. Employees
8 shall be provided Workmen's Compensation coverage, Health
9 Insurance, and shall be members of the Guam Retirement
10 Fund, provided that contract employees shall not be
11 members of the Guam Retirement Fund.

12 (b) The Station Manager shall be responsible for
13 recruitment of all employees of the Corporation."
