






AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE FUNDS IN THE GUM
MEMORIAL HOSPITAL FUND AND THE SUSANA
HOSPITAL FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND, TO
REPEAL SECTIONS 49011, 49012, AND 49013
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUM AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUM:

2 Section 1. The Gum Memorial Hospital Fund and the
3 Susana Hospital Fund are hereby closed. The monies in said
4 funds are transferred to the General Fund Unappropriated Surplus.

5 Section 2. Sections 49011, 49012 and 49013 of the Government
6 Code of Gum are hereby repealed.

7 Section 3. Section 19374 of the Government Code is hereby
8 repealed and reenacted to read:

9 "Section 19374. Delinquent: Date: Penalties.

10 All taxes due December 15 if unpaid, are delinquent February
11 20 of the following year at 12:00 midnight, and thereafter
12 a delinquent penalty attached to them in an amount equal
13 to nine percent (9%); provided, however, that the minimum
14 penalty under this Sections shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00)."

15 Section 4. Section 19375 of the Government Code is hereby
16 repealed and reenacted to read:

17 "Section 19375. Same: Same: Same. All taxes due
18 February 20 if unpaid are delinquent April 20 of each year
19 at 12:00 midnight and thereafter a delinquent penalty
20 attached to them in an amount equal to nine percent (9%);
21 provided, however, that the minimum penalty under this
22 Section shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00)."
