Introduced by J. H. Underwood

AN ACT TO ADD NEW SUBSECTIONS 23319.3(a)  
THROUGH (k) TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO  
PROVIDE FOR PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES  
AND TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR THE DRIVERS  
EDUCATION FUND.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby added to the Government Code  
3 a new Subsection 23319.3(a) - (k) to read:

4 "23319.3(a). Purpose. The purpose of this article  
5 is to provide revenue for the Drivers Education Fund.

6 (b) Application. Any person who is the registered  
7 owner or lessee of a passenger vehicle, commercial vehicle  
8 or trailer registered with the department or who makes  
9 application for an original registration or renewal  
10 registration of any such vehicle may, upon payment of the  
11 fee prescribed in Section 23319.3(g) of this article,  
12 apply to the department for personalized license plates,  
13 in the manner prescribed in Section 23319.3(f) which plates  
14 shall be affixed to the passenger vehicle, commercial vehicle,  
15 or trailer for which registration is sought in lieu of  
16 the regular license plates.

17 (c) Color and Design. The personalized license  
18 plates shall be the same color and design as regular  
19 passenger vehicle, commercial vehicle, or trailer license  
20 plates, and shall consist of number or letters, or any  
21 combination thereof not exceeding six positions provided  
22 that there are no conflicts with existing passenger,  
23 commercial, trailer, motorcycle, or special license  
24 plates series or with the provisions of Sections 23319.1  
25 and 23319.2.

1 (d) Personalized License Plates: Defined.

2 "Personalized license plates," as used in this article  
3 means license plates that have displayed upon them the  
4 registration number assigned to the passenger vehicle,  
5 commercial vehicle, or trailer for which such registration  
6 number was issued in a combination of letters or numbers,  
7 or both, requested by the owner or lessee of the vehicle.

8 (e) Issuance. Personalized license plates shall be  
9 issued only to the registered owner or lessee of the  
10 vehicle on which they are to be displayed.

11 (f) Form and Date of Application: Letters and  
12 Numbers. An applicant for issuance of personalized  
13 license plates or renewal of such plates in the  
14 subsequent year pursuant to this article shall file an  
15 application therefor in such form and by such date as the  
16 department may require indicating thereon the combination  
17 of letters or numbers, or both, requested as a registration  
18 number. There shall be no duplication of registration  
19 numbers.

20 (g) Additional Fees. In addition to the regular  
21 registration fee, the applicant shall be charged the  
22 cost of the personalized plate plus additional \$25.00. In  
23 addition to the regular renewal fee, the applicant for a  
24 renewal of such plates shall be charged an additional fee  
25 of ten dollars (\$10.00).

26 (h) Drivers Education Fund. All revenue derived  
27 from the fees provided for in Sections 23319.3(g) and  
28 23319.3(i) shall be deposited in the Drivers Education  
29 Fund.

1           (i) Transfer Fee. Whenever any person who has been  
2 issued personalized license plates applies to the depart-  
3 ment for transfer of such plates to another passenger  
4 vehicle, commercial vehicle, or trailer, a transfer fee of  
5 twelve dollars (\$12) shall be charged in addition to all  
6 other appropriate fees.

7           (j) Transfer or Surrender of Plates. When any person  
8 who has been issued personalized license plates sells,  
9 trades, or otherwise releases ownership of the vehicle  
10 upon which the personalized license plates have been  
11 displayed, he shall immediately report the transfer of such  
12 plates to an acquired passenger vehicle, commercial  
13 vehicle, or trailer pursuant to Section 23319.3(i) or he  
14 shall surrender such plates to the department forthwith.

15           (k) Rules and Regulations. The Director may  
16 establish rules and regulations as may be necessary to  
17 carry out the purposes of this article."
