AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER III (A) TO
TITLE XII OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A BASIC EDUCATION
PROGRAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter III (A) is hereby added to
3 Title XII of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "CHAPTER III (A)

5 Basic Education

6 Section 11220. Basic Education. The Board shall
7 implement an educational program with a curriculum
8 for grades one through twelve that provides for the
9 development of competence and mastery of the basic
10 skills of reading, writing and mathematics. The
11 curriculum shall define in specific and measurable terms
12 the competency levels and learning outcomes which
13 students are expected to achieve. The curriculum shall
14 also contain appropriate evaluation procedures to assess
15 student performance in the basic skills at the beginning
16 and ending of each academic year in any grade level.

17 Section 11221. Same: evaluation. The Board
18 shall develop procedures for systematically evaluating
19 the extent to which all intended outcomes are being
20 achieved.

1 Section 11222. Same: same. The Board shall
2 evaluate the efficiency of the instructional program
3 in contributing to the achievement of the basic skills
4 and shall continually revise both outcome statements
5 and instructional procedures on the basis of evaluative
6 data.

7 Section 11223. Implementation. The basic education
8 program shall be implemented in at least one school to
9 be designated by the Board."
