AND ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 230 AND 231 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO CREATE A COLLISSION OF THE CHARLE SYSTEM IN THE TENDETOLY OF GUAM.

BE IT EMACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 230 is added to the Government Code
to read:

"Section 230. Commission on Matric System. The Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislature, shall appoint five (5) members to the Commission on the Metric System. Commission members shall serve until December 1, 1976, at which time the Commission shall dissolve. The duties of the Commission are to conduct such studies and research as are necessary to make recommendations as to how the government of Guam can best make the transition from the current system of weights and measures to the metric system. The Commission shall submit its report to the Governor and to the Legislature no later than December 1, 1976.

Section 231. No later than February 1, 1977, all departments, agencies, authorities and government owned corporations shall be required to use the metric system in addition to the current system of weights and measures in all data, specifications, publications, writings, announcements, bulletins, rules, regulations or any other place in which weights and measurements are quoted."
