AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$44,700) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE ROOF OF THE JOINT INARAJAN COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE AND FIRE STATION BUILDING, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Forty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$44,700) from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the purpose of the reconstruction of the roof of the joint Inarajan Commissioner's Office and Fire Station Building.

Section 2. Section 16 of Part I of Public Law 12-60, as amended by Section 6, Public Law 13-3, is further amended to read as follows:

"Section 16. The sum of One Million Dollars

(\$1,000,000) is hereby appropriated from any available

funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund

for improvements to the existing facilities of the

Guam Memorial Hospital, to be allocated to the following:
