


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Substitute Bill No. 603, "An Act to add a new Chapter 3 to Title LXVI of the Government Code to provide for a Guam International Air Terminal Gaming Zone", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on December 5, 1975, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 10th day of December, 1975, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 15 members.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 3 TO TITLE LXVI
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE FOR A GUAM
INTERNATIONAL AIR TERMINAL GAMING ZONE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter 3 is added to Title LXVI of
3 the Government Code to read:

4 "CHAPTER 3

5 GUAM INTERNATIONAL AIR TERMINAL GAMING ZONE

6 Section 62200. Gaming Zone: Establishment. There
7 is at the Guam International Air Terminal a gaming zone.
8 The gaming zone shall exist in and be coterminous with
9 the transit lounge at the Guam International Air Terminal.

10 Section 62201. Same: Laws. Gambling by the use
11 of any mechanical device which offers money as a prize
12 or reward to players upon the attainment of certain
13 combination or combinations of symbols of three or more
14 reels contained within such device, the revolution of
15 which reels is mechanically controlled and results in
16 random combination of such symbols commonly referred to
17 as slot machines, shall be allowed within the Guam
18 International Air Terminal Gaming Zone only and any law,
19 rule or regulation to the contrary shall have no effect
20 within said Gaming Zone, provided that nothing in this
21 Chapter shall be construed as to make inapplicable any
22 of the taxes imposed by Title XX of this Code within said
23 Gaming Zone.

1 Section 62202. Slot Machines: Odds. It shall be
2 unlawful to offer for play within the Gaming Zone any
3 slot machine unless such slot machine has been adjusted
4 to return not less than eighty percent (80%), on the
5 average, of all money played to the players thereof.

6 Section 62203. Same: Minors. Persons under the
7 age of eighteen (18) are prohibited from playing the
8 slot machines in the Gaming Zone and it shall be a
9 misdemeanor for any person to permit any person under
10 the age of eighteen (18) years to play any slot machine
11 in said zone.

12 Section 62204. Same: Prohibition. No one shall
13 be allowed to enter said Guam International Air Terminal
14 Gaming Zone except an airline passenger in transit and/or
15 a departing passenger, provided that the Guam Airport
16 Authority Board by regulation may allow for the entrance
17 of maintenance, custodial, operational, and supervisory
18 personnel; provided also that agents of the Department of
19 Public Safety, Revenue and Taxation, and Customs and
20 Quarantine officers of the Department of Commerce may enter
21 said Gaming Zone pursuant to the performance of their
22 duties; provided further, however, that any person other
23 than an airline passenger in transit and a departing
24 passenger shall be absolutely prohibited from using or
25 playing the slot machines in said Gaming Zone. For the
26 purposes of this Chapter (a) an airline passenger in
27 transit is defined as a person who has boarded an aircraft
28 at a point outside of Guam for a flight which will
29 terminate at a point outside of Guam who, during the time
30 that the said aircraft is on the ground in Guam to take

1 on or discharge passengers or for refueling, has tempo-
2 rarily disembarked from the said aircraft and who will
3 immediately reboard the said aircraft for departure from
4 Guam. (b) A departing passenger is defined as a person
5 who has a valid ticket for an aircraft which will depart
6 within two hours from the Guam International Air Terminal
7 for a destination outside Guam after such person has in
8 good faith completed all requirements, as established
9 by federal or local law, rule or regulation and the
10 regulations of the airline involved, for boarding said
11 aircraft.

12 Section 62205. Same: Same: Penalties. Any un-
13 authorized entry into the Guam International Air Terminal
14 Gaming Zone is a misdemeanor to be punished by a fine
15 of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500). Any person operating
16 or playing a slot machine in the Guam International Air
17 Terminal Gaming Zone who is not an airline passenger in
18 transit or a departing passenger shall be guilty of a
19 misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined
20 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500).

21 Section 62206. Same: Lease. The Guam Airport
22 Authority Board shall lease the Guam Gaming Zone to the
23 Guam Gaming Commission which shall operate the Gaming
24 Zone on its own behalf.

25 Section 62207. Same: Same: Terms. The lease
26 entered into pursuant to this Chapter may allow the
27 lessee to sell alcoholic beverages by the drink and to
28 enter into other activities not prohibited by law.

29 Section 62208. Same: Same: Proceeds. All pro-
30 ceeds from any lease entered into pursuant to this

1 Chapter shall be paid into the Guam Airport Authority
2 Fund established by Section 62010 of this Title. All
3 other proceeds shall be credited to the General Fund.

4 Section 62209. Same: Same: Contract. A lease
5 entered into pursuant to this section shall be a contract
6 between the Authority and the lessee, and the obligations
7 and benefits of said contract may not be curtailed,
8 limited or impaired by any subsequent law.

9 Section 62210. The Guam International Air Terminal
10 Gaming Zone is exempted from the provisions of 1172, Title
11 XV, of the U. S. Code."

12 Section 2. A new Section 25312.1 is added to the Govern-
13 ment Code to read:

14 "Section 25312.1. Section 25312 shall not apply to
15 the sale of alcoholic beverages within the Guam Inter-
16 national Air Terminal Gaming Zone."

17 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective
18 upon the establishment by law of the Guam Gaming Commission
19 and adoption except that the Gaming Zone shall not be established
20 until the transit lounge at Guam International Air Terminal,
21 which is currently under construction, is completed.

22 Section 4. Application. This Act shall have no application
23 outside of the Gaming Zone created by Section 1 of this Act.
24 This Act shall not be deemed to be repealed by implication by
25 subsequent acts embracing the same subject or subjects unless
26 said subsequent act or acts expressly repeal this Act or any
27 of the provisions hereof.
