session at the seat of government at 5 p.m., on the first Monday in January of each year, for ten (10) legislative days and thereafter every first Monday for five (5) legislative days of each month through December."

Section 3. A new Section 6118.4 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 6118.4. Contingent Expenses and Contingent Fund. Whenever the terms "contingent expenses" and "contingent fund" are used in any appropriation act, they shall include, but not limited to, entertainment expenses for official purposes."
