

Introduced by Committee on Rules

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
OPERATION OF THE THIRTEENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1976.
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of Two Million Seven Hundred Fifty
3 Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$2,750,133)
4 is appropriated from any available surplus in the Unappro-
5 priated Surplus of the General Fund to the Legislative
6 Operations Fund for the operation of the Thirteenth Guam
7 Legislature for the calendar year ending December 31, 1976,
8 to be utilized in the following categories:

9 I. For 12 Senators to include Salaries
10 and Personal Benefits, not

11 to exceed \$254,316

12 II. For the expenses of the Standing
13 Committees of the Thirteenth Guam
14 Legislature, to include personal
15 services, personnel benefits, travel
16 and transportation, other contractual
17 services, supplies and materials,
18 equipment and miscellaneous expenses,
19 not to exceed Six Hundred Fifteen
20 Thousand Dollars (\$615,000)

21 A. For the Committee on Rules,

22 not to exceed \$ 54,000

23 B. For the Committee on Man-
24 power, Resources and Economic

25 Development, not to exceed \$ 54,000

- C. For the Committee on Youth
and Senior Citizens, not to
exceed \$ 54,000
- D. For the Committee on Education,
not to exceed \$ 35,000
- E. For the Committee on Finance
and Taxation, not to exceed \$ 54,000
- F. For the Committee on General
Governmental Operations, not
to exceed the total of
Fifty Thousand Dollars
(\$50,000) as follows:
For Personal Services and
benefit, not to exceed \$ 28,000
For Contractual Services,
not to exceed \$ 18,000
For Supplies and Materials,
not to exceed \$ 1,500
For Equipment and Miscellaneous
expenses, not to exceed \$ 2,500
- G. For the Committee on Health,
Welfare and Ecology, not to
exceed \$ 54,000
- H. For the Committee on Housing
and Public Utilities, not
to exceed \$ 60,000
- I. For the Committee on Judiciary,
not to exceed \$ 60,000
- J. For the Committee on Public
Safety, Military and Veterans

1 Affairs, not to exceed \$ 60,000

2 K. For the Committee on Commerce,
3 Tourism and Transportation,
4 not to exceed \$ 25,000

5 L. Speaker's Contingency Fund \$ 20,000

6 M. For the Office of the Speaker \$ 35,000

7 III. For the expenses of the operation of the
8 Office of the Minority, not to exceed
9 the total of Eight Hundred Thirty-Three
10 Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty-Nine
11 Dollars (\$833,959) to include but not
12 limited to, personal services, personnel
13 benefits, travel and transportation,
14 other contractual services, supplies and
15 materials, equipment, and miscellaneous
16 and contingent expenses.

17 IV. General Operation of the Thirteenth
18 Guam Legislature:

19 A. For expenses of the General
20 Operation to include personal
21 services and personnel benefits
22 not to exceed One Million Forty-
23 Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-
24 Eight Dollars (\$1,046,858).

25 Section 2. Section 1015 of the Government Code is
26 amended to read:

27 "Section 1015 (a). Legislature. Convening and
28 adjourning of sessions: carry over from odd-year regular
29 sessions; first and second regular sessions.

30 "(a) The Legislature shall convene in regular

1 session at the seat of government at 5 p.m., on the
2 first Monday in January of each year, for ten (10)
3 legislative days and thereafter every first Monday
4 for five (5) legislative days of each month through
5 December."

6 Section 3. A new Section 6118.4 is hereby added to the
7 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

8 "Section 6118.4. Contingent Expenses and Contingent
9 Fund. Whenever the terms "contingent expenses" and
10 "contingent fund" are used in any appropriation act,
11 they shall include, but not limited to, entertainment
12 expenses for official purposes."
