Introduced by Committee on Rules at the request of the Governor

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 349 OF CHAPTER VI, TITLE III, PART II OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO RELEASE OF ARRESTED PERSONS.

Section 1. Section 849 of Chapter VI, Title III, Part II of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 349. Person arrested without a warrant to be taken before a magistrate. Information or complaint to be filed. When an arrest is made without a warrant by a peace officer or private person, the person arrested must, without unnecessary delay, unless otherwise released, be taken before the nearest or (most) accessible magistrate, and an information or a complaint stating the charge against the person, must be laid before such magistrate."

Section 2. Section 1111 of Chapter 1, Title VI, Part 2 of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. Section 2 of this Act shall be effective immediately, however, it shall not apply to the prosecution

of those charged with a crime prior to that date.
