AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1, CATEGORY IV AND  
TO ADD A NEW CATEGORY V OF PUBLIC LAW 13-1  
RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THREE  
THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$3,550)  
FOR THE FIRST YOUTH CONGRESS UP TO  
JANUARY 10, 1976.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 1, Category IV of Public Law 13-1  
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1.

5 IV. General Operations of the Thirteenth Guam  
6 Legislature:

7 A. For expenses of the General Operations  
8 of the Thirteenth Guam Legislature not to  
9 exceed the total of Eight Hundred Sixty-Five  
10 Thousand Three Hundred Eight Dollars (\$865,308)  
11 to include personal services and personnel  
12 benefits of following:

13 (1) General Administration

14 Division \$229,765

15 (2) Legislative Attaches \$ 64,694

16 (3) Legal Supportive Services

17 Division \$134,230

18 (4) Fiscal Services Division \$128,206

19 (5) Public Affairs Division \$216,578

20 (6) Planning and Research

21 Division \$ 91,835

1 B. For expenses of the General Operations  
2 of the Thirteenth Guam Legislature, not to  
3 exceed the total of Two Hundred Ninety-Nine  
4 Thousand Dollars (\$299,000) to include travel  
5 and transportation, other contractual services,  
6 supplies and materials, equipment and miscella-  
7 neous expenses."

8 Section 2. A new Category V is hereby added to Section 1  
9 of Public Law 13-1 relative to appropriating Three Thousand  
10 Five Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$3,550) for the operation of the  
11 First Youth Congress to read as follows:

12 "V. Youth Congress:

13 A. For the initial operation of the Youth  
14 Congress, including salaries for the  
15 members, not to exceed the total of Three  
16 Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Dollars  
17 (\$3,550.00)."

18 Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law 12-110 is hereby  
19 amended to read as follows:

20 "Section 2. The sum of Six Hundred Seventy-Five  
21 Thousand Dollars (\$675,000) appropriated pursuant to  
22 Section 5 of Bill No. 676, as substituted, is hereby  
23 reappropriated to the Guam Transit Authority to be used  
24 for the purposes set forth in this Act. In the event  
25 that Bill No. 676, as substituted, is not enacted into  
26 law, there is hereby appropriated from any available funds  
27 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
28 sum of Six Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars  
29 (\$675,000) to be used for the purpose of purchasing  
30 transit type buses to be used as set forth in this Act.

1 If, at the effective date of this Act, the Board of  
2 Directors of the Guam Transit Authority is not organized,  
3 the Director of Public Works shall have the authority to  
4 carry out the purposes of this Act including, but not  
5 limited to, the purchase of transit type buses."

6 Section 4. ~~The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars~~  
7 ~~(\$25,000)~~ is hereby appropriated from any available surplus in  
8 the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the operation  
9 of the Office of the Legislative Secretary to be apportioned  
10 as follows:

19 Section 5. This Act shall be effective immediately.
