AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE RECREATION SITE
SITUATED BETWEEN THE TAMUNING ELEMENTARY
AND L. B. JOHNSON SCHOOLS FROM THE DEPARTMENT
OF EDUCATION TO THE NEW DEPARTMENT OF PARKS
AND RECREATION AND TO DESIGNATE SAID SITE
AS A PARK AND RECREATION AREA FOR THE MUNICI-
PALITY OF TAMUNING-TUMON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The recreation site situated between the
3 Tamuning Elementary and L. B. Johnson Schools is hereby trans-
4 ferred from the jurisdiction of the Department of Education to
5 the new Department of Parks and Recreation.

6 Section 2. The recreation site stated in Section 1 of
7 this Act shall be herein designated as the Tamuning Recreation
8 Park.

9 Section 3. The Department of Parks and Recreation shall
10 cooperate fully with the Office of the Commissioner of Tamuning-
11 Tumon in the implementation of sports activities on and the
12 maintenance of this park.

13 Section 4. This Act shall take effect upon its enactment
14 into law.
