Introduced by A. C. Ysrael

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 18301 (c) OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THE
GOVERNMENT TO ACCEPT DEDICATION OF RIGHTS-
OF-WAY IN EXISTING AGRICULTURAL SUBDIVISIONS.

1 AS IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Subsection (c) is hereby added to
3 Section 18301 of the Government Code of Guam to read as
4 follows:

5 (c) Acceptance of dedication to be signed by
6 the Governor. The Governor shall not withhold acceptance
7 of the dedication of any right-of-way in any agricultural
8 subdivision provided the subdivision shall have had
9 de facto existence at the time of this Act and the
10 right-of-way is at least 20 feet wide, provided,
11 however, that the owners of the properties within said
12 subdivision shall organize themselves for the creation
13 of improvement districts for the construction, or
14 reconstruction, of needed public facilities in accordance
15 with the provisions of the Improvement District Law
16 (Chapter I, Title XLV, Government Code), as amended;
17 and provided further that the acceptance of the
18 dedication herein authorized shall become effective
19 only after the Governor of Guam shall have given his
20 approval of the final report by Executive Order required
21 Section 48021 of the said Government Code."
