Introduced by A. C. Ysrael

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 10301 (c) OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THE  
GOVERNMENT TO ACCEPT DEDICATION OF RIGHTS-  
OF-WAY IN EXISTING AGRICULTURAL SUBDIVISIONS.

AS IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Subsection (c) is hereby added to  
Section 10301 of the Government Code of Guam to read as  
follows:

"(c) Acceptance of dedication to be signed by  
the Governor. The Governor shall not withhold acceptance  
of the dedication of any right-of-way in any agricultural  
subdivision provided the subdivision shall have had  
de facto existence at the time of this Act and the  
right-of-way is at least 20 feet wide, provided,  
however, that the owners of the properties within said  
subdivision shall organize themselves for the creation  
of improvement districts for the construction, or  
reconstruction, of needed public facilities in accordance  
with the provisions of the Improvement District Law  
(Chapter I, Title XLV, Government Code), as amended;  
and provided further that the acceptance of the  
dedication herein authorized shall become effective  
only after the Governor of Guam shall have given his  
approval of the final report by Executive Order required  
Section 48021 of the said Government Code."
