AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE DREDGING OF TUHON BAY AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CEMENT WALK ALONG TUMON BAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PECPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The Director of Public Works is hereby directed to conduct, or cause to be conducted, a feasibility study for the dredging of Tumon Bay and for the construction of a cement walk along Tumon Bay to the end that such dredging and construction will enchance the recreational potentials of the Bay. The study shall also include, but not limited to, the financial feasibility of selling the dredged materials to fund the dredging and construction projects.

Section 2. Within One Hundred and Twenty (120) days of the effective date of this Act, the Director of Public Works shall submit a copy of the feasibility study report to the Legislature.

Section 3. All agencies of government affected by the provisions of this Act are herewith directed to cooperate fully with the Director of Public Works in the implementation of those provisions.
