AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DIRECTOR OF  
PUBLIC WORKS TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY  
STUDY FOR THE DREDGING OF TUMON BAY  
AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CEMENT  
WALK ALONG TUMON BAY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Director of Public Works is hereby directed  
3 to conduct, or cause to be conducted, a feasibility study for  
4 the dredging of Tumon Bay and for the construction of a cement  
5 walk along Tumon Bay to the end that such dredging and construc-  
6 tion will enhance the recreational potentials of the Bay. The  
7 study shall also include, but not limited to, the financial  
8 feasibility of selling the dredged materials to fund the  
9 dredging and construction projects.

10 Section 2. Within One Hundred and Twenty (120) days of  
11 the effective date of this Act, the Director of Public Works  
12 shall submit a copy of the feasibility study report to the  
13 Legislature.

14 Section 3. All agencies of government affected by the  
15 provisions of this Act are herewith directed to cooperate fully  
16 with the Director of Public Works in the implementation of  
17 those provisions.
