AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON THE POLITICAL STATUS OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Special Commission on the Political Status of Guam for the specific purpose of conducting an educational program on the political status referendum to be conducted on September 4, 1976.

Section 2. Unexpended or unencumbered balances from the appropriation made in Section 1 of this Act shall revert back to the General Fund no later than September 3, 1976.

Section 3. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Special Commission on the Political Status of Guam for the purpose of defraying expenses incurred as a result of status negotiations with representatives of the federal government.

Section 4. Unexpended or unencumbered balances from the appropriation made in Section 3 of this Act shall revert back to the General Fund no later than June 30, 1978.

Section 5. The sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Election Commission for the purpose of defraying the additional expenses incurred by the Commission in carrying out the referendum on political status.
