




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4. V.C. AND D OF
PUBLIC LAW 13-137 RELATIVE TO THE OPERATIONS
OF THE FIRST GUAM YOUTH CONGRESS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4. V. C. and D of Public Law 13-137
3 is hereby amended as follows:

4 "V. Youth Congress:

5 C. For Contractual Services of a Legal
6 Officer for all regular sessions and the
7 preparation of bills and resolutions
8 for introduction, not to exceed \$5,000

9 D. For supplies, materials, and other
10 contractual services, equipment and
11 miscellaneous expenses, including
12 conferences, not to exceed \$6,250"

13 Section 2. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
