AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE AND TRANSFER THE SUM OF TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,500,000) TO FAY TO ELIGIBLE VETERANS BONUSES AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER XIV-A, TITLE IX OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authorization for appropriation contained in Section 2 of Public Law 11-146 there is hereby appropriated from any tax revenue realized from the operation of the Greyhound Racing Tracks authorized by Public Law 13-26 the sum of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000) to pay to eligible veterans the bonuses authorized by Section 8981 of the Government Code of Guam, and transferred to a special account in the General Fund, said sum to be allocated and used for the purpose of paying to eligible veterans the bonuses authorized by Chapter XIV-A, Title IX of the Government Code of Guam.

Section 2. The Veterans' Affairs Office is hereby authorized to utilize a portion of this appropriation for postage, supplies, and contractual services to update the computerized veteran's file necessary to implement this act, not to exceed Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000).

Section 3. The Veterans' Affairs Officer of the Office of Veterans' Affairs, Government of Guam, shall provide the Chairman of the Committee on Public Safety, Military and Veterans' Affairs with a written report every thirty (30) days following the opening date of Guam's first Greyhound Racing Track after the enactment of this measure into law, said written report to include, inter alia, the number of eligible persons entitled to receive bonuses, the names of those persons who have in fact received the bonuses, the amounts received and other pertinent information regarding implementation of this Act.
