

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE AND TRANSFER THE  
SUM OF TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND  
DOLLARS (\$2,500,000) TO PAY TO ELIGIBLE  
VETERANS BONUSES AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER  
XIV-A, TITLE IX OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF  
GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Pursuant to the authorization for appropriation  
3 contained in Section 2 of Public Law 11-146 there is hereby  
4 appropriated from any tax revenue realized from the operation  
5 of the Greyhound Racing Tracks authorized by Public Law 13-26  
6 the sum of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars  
7 (\$2,500,000) to pay to eligible veterans the bonuses authorized  
8 by Section 8981 of the Government Code of Guam, and transferred  
9 to a special account in the General Fund, said sum to be allo-  
10 cated and used for the purpose of paying to eligible veterans  
11 the bonuses authorized by Chapter XIV-A, Title IX of the  
12 Government Code of Guam.

13 Section 2. The Veterans' Affairs Office is hereby  
14 authorized to utilize a portion of this appropriation for  
15 postage, supplies, and contractual services to update the  
16 computerized veteran's file necessary to implement this act,  
17 not to exceed Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000).

1           Section 3. The Veterans' Affairs Officer of the Office  
2 of Veterans' Affairs, Government of Guam, shall provide the  
3 Chairman of the Committee on Public Safety, Military and  
4 Veterans' Affairs with a written report every thirty (30) days  
5 following the opening date of Guam's first Greyhound Racing  
6 Track after the enactment of this measure into law, said  
7 written report to include, inter alia, the number of eligible  
8 persons entitled to receive bonuses, the names of those  
9 persons who have in fact received the bonuses, the amounts  
10 received and other pertinent information regarding implementa-  
11 tion of this Act.
