Section 16. The appropriations made in Section 14 of this Act shall be subject to the Administrative Provisions contained in Public Law 13-148.

Section 17. Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation, to the contrary neither the Governor nor any of his representatives shall withhold any portion of any appropriation made by P. L. 13-148, P. L. 13-149 and Sections 1 thru 14, inclusive, of this Act.

Section 18. This Act shall have immediate effect.
