AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE UTILIZATION OF GOVERNMENT HOUSING BY GUAM HOUSING AND URBAN REGIWAL AUTHORITY FOR LOW INCOME HOUSING PROGRAMS THROUGH THE REPEAL AND REENACTHENT OF SECTIONS 4300 AND 4302 AND REPEAL OF SECTIONS 4360.1, 4301, 4303 AND 4304 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 4300 of the Government Code is repealed and reenacted to read:

"Section 4300. Government Housing. (a) Any housing unit leased or owned by the Government of Guam and used for any purpose other than that provided for by Subsection (b) shall be managed by the Director of Administration or his designee.

housing units which are excess to its needs it may, by order of the Governor, relinquish management of such units to Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. Any housing unit relinquished to the management of Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority shall be utilized by the authority in the furtherance of its powers and duties as provided for in Section 13903 of the Government Code. Any rent derived from the use of a unit relinquished to Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority shall be used first to reimburse the authority for any sum expended upon the unit for maintenance or administration; any remaining rent shall be paid into the Housing Revolving Fund

Housing and Urban Renewal Authority of a unit for management and use within its low income housing program shall not impose upon the authority any responsibility for the payment of any rent due from the Government of Guam to the lessor of the unit.

becomes excess to the needs of the government it may be conveyed by the Governor, in consideration of the payment of One Dollar (\$1.00) per unit, to Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. Any housing unit conveyed to Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority shall be utilized by the authority in the furtherance of its powers and duties as provided for by Section 13903 of the Government Code. For purposes of this Subsection 'housing unit' means a single family detached dwelling and the lot upon which it is situated."

Section 2. Sections 4300.1, 4301, 4303 and 4304 of the Government Code are repealed.

Section 3. Section 4302 of the Government Code is rerepealed and reenacted to read:

"Section 4302. Housing Revolving Fund. (a) There is established a fund to be known as the 'Housing Revolving Fund'. This fund shall be maintained separate and apart from other funds of the Government of Guam and independent records shall be kept as to its use.

- (c) All expenses of providing and maintaining rental housing for persons holding as subtenants under the Government of Guam shall be paid from the Housing Revolving Fund. These expenses shall be paid by the Treasurer of Guam upon vouchers properly certified by the Director of Administration.
- (d) The Director of Administration shall annually transmit to the Legislature a budget projecting proposed expenditures and receipts of the fund."

  Section 4. This Act shall take effect September 1, 1976.
