AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO CONVEY CERTAIN GOVERNMENT OF GUAM LOTS TO THE GUAM TELEPHONE AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, a dependable telephone system is a prerequisite to an improved economy; and

WHEREAS, the telephone system on Guam requires substantial repair and replacement to provide much needed telephone service; and

WHEREAS, this upgrading will require a substantial amount of money; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Telephone Authority has received a loan commitment from the Rural Electrification Administration (REA), for an amount not to exceed Twenty-Two Million Dollars (\$22,000,000); and

WHEREAS, a prerequisite to the first advance of funds is evidence that the Guam Telephone Authority has marketable title to its existing real estate; and

WHEREAS, at the present time, the Guam Telephone Authority is using government of Guam land in certain locations;

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Governor of Guam is hereby authorized to convey to the Guam Telephone Authority, at One Dollar (\$1.00) consideration, the herein listed government of Guam land, to be used by the Guam Telephone Authority for telephone operations. Section 2. The lots to be conveyed by Section 1 of this
Act are as follows:

Lot No. 1-1, Block 30, Municipality of Agana, containing an area of 1,375 square meters.
Lot No. 5120-4 NEW, Municipality of Dededo, containing an area of 27,032 square meters.
Lot No. 10063, Municipality of Dededo, containing an area of 2,856.93 square meters.
Lot No. 443 Part 1-3, Municipality of Agat, containing an area of 1,310 square meters, reference: LM-B4-62T267.

 Lot No. 7004-6-1, Municipality of Yigo, containing an area of 1,579.37 square meters.

 Lot No. 1109-2, Municipality of Barrigada, containing an area of 1,500 square meters.

Section 3. Any land transferred under the provisions of this Act shall revert to the government of Guam when and if said land ceases to be used for the purpose of telephone operations.

Section 4. This Act shall be effective immediately upon approval.
