


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER II TO TITLE XXXIV
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM
VISITORS BUREAU TO ISSUE TOURIST STAMPS AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter II is added to Title XXXIV of
3 the Government Code to read:

4 "CHAPTER II

5 TOURIST STAMPS

6 Section 38100. Definitions. Unless the context
7 otherwise requires, the following provisions shall govern
8 the construction of this Chapter:

9 (a) 'Tourist stamps' means paper devices which
10 are gummed on one side and printed on the other and
11 designed in such a manner that they may be affixed to
12 the outside of the envelopes. The stamps shall be
13 the same approximate dimensions as those of the

1 Christmas or Easter Seals and may be issued in book-
2 lets or shirts in any denomination, and shall be
3 printed on one side. Said printing shall consist of
4 the Guam Seal, a historic or scenic view of Guam,
5 and/or such other matter as the Board finds proper.

6 (b) 'Board' means the Board of Directors of
7 the Guam Visitors Bureau.

8 Section 38101. The Board is authorized to issue
9 tourist stamps from time to time in such denominations and
10 in such quantities as it finds advisable.

11 Section 38102. In accordance with the laws of Guam,
12 the Board may enter into contracts for the production and
13 marketing of tourist stamps.

14 Section 38103. The net proceeds from the sale of
15 tourist stamps shall be funds of the Guam Visitors Bureau
16 for use in the promotion of tourism. Said funds shall be
17 considered part of the government's contribution to the
18 Guam Visitors Bureau's annual operating budget .

19 Section 38104. The Guam Visitors Bureau shall annually
20 submit reports to the Governor and to the Legislature of
21 transactions within Sections 38101, 38102, and 38103
22 herein."

23 // Section 2. Section 35 of Public Law 12-60 is amended to
24 read as follows:

25 "Section 35. There is hereby established a Library
26 Building Reserve Account within the Unappropriated Surplus
27 of the General Fund for the construction of a new public
28 library, or to upgrade or extend the current public
29 library facility. No monies from this account shall be
30 committed, transferred, or expended except pursuant to an
31 appropriation enacted by the Guam Legislature." //
