




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





1 Section 3. Section 4116.4 of the Government Code of Guam
2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "4116.4. Autonomous Agencies. Notwithstanding any
4 other provisions of law, no board or commission, the
5 Legislature, or any agency which is authorized to establish
6 compensation rates for its employees shall pay any
7 employee nor contract for the services of any person at a
8 rate of more than \$29,000 per year unless any such
9 compensation rate and job opening shall be published five
10 (5) consecutive days in a newspaper of general circulation
11 in Guam; provided that any such compensation exceeding
12 \$29,000 per annum shall not become effective earlier than
13 forty-five (45) days from the fifth day of its publication
14 as required herein. This provision shall not be construed
15 to impair the obligations of the existing contract for
16 classified or unclassified employees. The provisions of
17 this section shall include Guam Visitors Bureau as long
18 as it receives contributions or subsidies from the
19 Government of Guam.

20 (a) 'Compensation Rate' as used in Section 4116.4
21 includes salaries, wages, and personal expense accounts."
