

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 233 TO THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE A MARIANAS FISHING  
DERBY AND TO CREATE A MARIANAS FISHING DERBY  
COMMITTEE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 233 is hereby added to the Government  
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 233. Marianas Fishing Derby. There shall be  
5 a Marianas Fishing Derby held annually, which event shall  
6 be promoted as a tourist attraction for visitors to Guam  
7 and as an outdoor recreational activity for the people of  
8 Guam. The Governor of Guam shall appoint a Marianas  
9 Fishing Derby Committee, composed of sport fishermen and  
10 other interested individuals, which Committee annually shall  
11 choose a period for such derby and shall plan, organize and  
12 promote it. The Governor, following selection of the  
13 dates by the Committee, shall issue a proclamation calling  
14 upon the sports fishermen of Guam and the Pacific to take  
15 part in the event."

16 Section 2. Section 230 of the Government Code is amended  
17 to read:

18 "Section 230. Commission on Metric System. The  
19 Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislature,  
20 shall appoint five (5) members to the Commission on the  
21 Metric System. Commission members shall serve until

1 December 1, 1978, at which time the Commission shall  
2 dissolve. The duties of the Commission are to conduct such  
3 studies and research as are necessary to make recommendations  
4 as to how the government of Guam can best make the  
5 transition from the current system of weights and measures  
6 to the metric system. The Commission shall submit its  
7 report to the Governor and to the Legislature no later than  
8 December 1, 1978."

9 Section 3. Section 231 of the Government Code (see Public  
10 Law 13-102) is hereby repealed.
