AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 490.1 TO THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM AND SECTION 43.70 TO THE CRIMINAL AND CORRECTIONAL CODE TO REQUIRE THAT A PERSON CONVICTED OF THEFT OF LIVESTOCK PAY TO THE OWNER OF SUCH STOLEN LIVESTOCK THE VALUE THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 490.1 is hereby added to the Penal Code
of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 490.1. Reimbursement to owner of stolen livestock. In any case where there is a conviction under the provisions of Section 484 of this Code and the property stolen by the defendant was livestock, in addition to any fine or imprisonment imposed, the court shall direct that the defendant pay to the owner of the stolen livestock its fair market value as determined by the court. Failure to make such payment shall be deemed failure to pay a fine and punished accordingly."

Section 2. Section 43.70 is hereby added to the Criminal and Correctional Code of Guam (Public Law 13-185) to read as follows:

"Section 43.70. Reimbursement to owner of stolen livestock. In any case where there is a conviction under the provisions of Chapter 43 of this Code and the property stolen by the defendant was livestock, in addition to any

fine or imprisonment imposed, the court shall direct that 1 the defendant pay to the owner of the stolen livestock its 2 fair market value as determined by the court. Failure to 3 make such payment shall be deemed failure to pay a fine and punished accordingly." Section 3. Section 1501(a) of the Code of Civil Procedure 6 of the Territory of Guam is amended as follows: . 7 'State' includes any state, territory, or 8

possession of the United States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Northern Marianas, the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, and any foreign jurisdiction in which this or a substantially similar reciprocal law is in effect."

Section 4. Sections 1 and 3 of this Act shall be effective immediately. Section 2 of this Act shall be effective upon the effective date of the Criminal and Correctional Code and Section 1 shall be repealed on the effective date of the repeal of the Penal Code of Guam.
