

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 490.1 TO THE PENAL CODE
OF GUAM AND SECTION 43.70 TO THE CRIMINAL AND
CORRECTIONAL CODE TO REQUIRE THAT A PERSON
CONVICTED OF THEFT OF LIVESTOCK PAY TO THE
OWNER OF SUCH STOLEN LIVESTOCK THE VALUE
THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 490.1 is hereby added to the Penal Code
3 of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 490.1. Reimbursement to owner of stolen
5 livestock. In any case where there is a conviction under
6 the provisions of Section 484 of this Code and the property
7 stolen by the defendant was livestock, in addition to any
8 fine or imprisonment imposed, the court shall direct that
9 the defendant pay to the owner of the stolen livestock its
10 fair market value as determined by the court. Failure to
11 make such payment shall be deemed failure to pay a fine
12 and punished accordingly."

13 Section 2. Section 43.70 is hereby added to the Criminal
14 and Correctional Code of Guam (Public Law 13-185) to read as
15 follows:

16 "Section 43.70. Reimbursement to owner of stolen
17 livestock. In any case where there is a conviction under
18 the provisions of Chapter 43 of this Code and the property
19 stolen by the defendant was livestock, in addition to any

1 fine or imprisonment imposed, the court shall direct that
2 the defendant pay to the owner of the stolen livestock its
3 fair market value as determined by the court. Failure to
4 make such payment shall be deemed failure to pay a fine
5 and punished accordingly."

6 Section 3. Section 1501(a) of the Code of Civil Procedure
7 of the Territory of Guam is amended as follows:

8 "(a) 'State' includes any state, territory, or
9 possession of the United States, the District of Columbia,
10 the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Northern Marianas, the
11 Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, and any foreign
12 jurisdiction in which this or a substantially similar
13 reciprocal law is in effect."

14 Section 4. Sections 1 and 3 of this Act shall be effective
15 immediately. Section 2 of this Act shall be effective upon the
16 effective date of the Criminal and Correctional Code and Section
17 1 shall be repealed on the effective date of the repeal of the
18 Penal Code of Guam.
