




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONSTRUCT  
AN ELEVATED WATER-HOLDING TANK FOR THE  
INARAJAN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND ITS ENVIRONS  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

1  
2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
4 of One Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$152,000) to the  
5 Department of Public Works to construct an elevated water-holding  
6 tank having a capacity of seventy-five thousand (75,000) gallons  
7 for the Inarajan Junior High School and its environs in the  
8 municipality of Inarajan.

9 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law 13-145 is hereby amended  
10 to read as follows:

11 "Section 2. The Governor is authorized to borrow a  
12 sum not in excess of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000).  
13 Such monies shall be deposited in the Typhoon Pamela Relief  
14 Fund."

15 ~~Section 3. Section 3 of Public Law 13-145 is hereby~~  
16 ~~repealed.~~

17 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
18 surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars  
19 (\$15,000.00) for the printing of 1,000 copies of the Uniform  
20 Commercial Code of Guam.

21 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
22 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
23 of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for the purpose of reimbursing  
24 any employees or officers of the Government of Guam for legal  
25 expenses incurred on account of criminal prosecution for their  
26 acts done within the scope of their employment, where such  
27 employees or officers were accused, by the filing of an indict-  
28 ment or information, of a crime during the fiscal year 1976.
