AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONSTRUCT AN ELEVATED WATER-HOLDING TANK FOR THE INARAJAN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND ITS ENVIRONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$152,000) to the Department of Public Works to construct an elevated water-holding tank having a capacity of seventy-five thousand (75,000) gallons for the Inarajan Junior High School and its environs in the municipality of Inarajan.

Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law 13-145 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The Governor is authorized to borrow a sum not in excess of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000).

Such monies shall be deposited in the Typhoon Pamela Relief Fund."

Service 3. Section 3 of Public Law 13 145 is hereby

repealed.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for the printing of 1,000 copies of the Uniform Commercial Code of Guam.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for the purpose of reimbursing any employees or officers of the Government of Guam for legal expenses incurred on account of criminal prosecution for their acts done within the scope of their employment, where such employees or officers were accused, by the filing of an indictment or information, of a crime during the fiscal year 1976.
