

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO MAKE COMMITMENTS FOR RECRUITMENT OF INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL FROM OFF-ISLAND, FOR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES, FOR PROCUREMENT OF INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT AGAINST ITS OPERATIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1978.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Department of Education is hereby authorized
3 to make commitments, not to exceed the sums indicated below, for
4 recruitment of instructional personnel from off-island, for
5 contractual services, and for procurement of instructional
6 supplies and equipment and placement of orders for library
7 books and textbooks against the appropriations for the
8 department for fiscal year ending June 30, 1978:
