AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE FOURTEENTH GUAM LEGIS-LATURE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1977, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Two Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,950,000.00) is appropriated from any available surplus in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Legislative Operations Fund for the operation of the Fourteenth Guam Legislature for the calendar year ending December 31, 1977, to be utilized in the following categories:

> "I. For thirteen (13) Senators to include Salaries and Personal Benefits, not to exceed

\$276,931.00

For the expenses of the II. Standing Committees of the Fourteenth Guam Legislature, to include personal services, personnel benefits, travel and transportation, other contractual services, supplies and materials, equipment and miscellaneous expenses, not to exceed One Million Fifty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$1,053,000.00)

Section 2. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary those employees of the Thirteenth Guam Legislature who did not receive lump sum payment for accumulated annual leave and who are now employed by the Fourteenth Guam Legislature shall be allowed to carry over such annual leave to their period of employment in the Fourteenth Guam Legislature.

Section 3. Section 1 of Public Law 13-205 is hereby repealed. All expenditures charged against the appropriation made by Section 1 of Public Law 13-205 shall be transferred and charged to the appropriation made by this Act.

Section 4. Section 11102.1 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"Section 11102.1. Same: Elected Members. The members of the Board of Education shall be public officers elected from the districts delineated in Section 11102.2 in accordance with Title III of this Code, provided that the youth member shall be elected at-large and further provided that Title III of this Code notwithstanding, candidates for such election shall be nominated only as provided in Section 11102.3. The elections provided for in this Act shall be nonpartisan. No political party shall directly or indirectly sponsor, nominate or endorse any of the candidates for office."
