AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION TO ESTABLISH THE RONNIE TAVARES MEMORIAL TROPHY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 26020 is hereby added to the
Government Code to read as follows:

"Section 26020. There is hereby established the Ronnie Tavares Memorial Trophy to be awarded annually to the most outstanding Guam Major League Player, as determined through balloting by the league's players and coaches. This trophy shall be maintained by the Department of Parks and Recreation, who shall engrave or cause to be engraved names of recipients of such trophy. In addition, a replica of the trophy shall be awarded to the annual winner as a permanent token of his accomplishments." Section 2. Subsection 26017(d) of the Government Code is hereby repealed and new Subsections 26017(d) and 26017(e) are added to read as follows:

- "(d) Maintaining and arranging for such ceremony as is befitting the awarding of the Ronnie Tavares Memorial Trophy, created by Section 26020 of the Government Code; and
- (e) Performing such other duties and functions
 pertaining to the promotion of public recreation
 as may from time to time be prescribed by the

Director." 1 2 Section 3. The sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) is appropriated from the General Fund to provide for the 3 award ereated by Section 1 of this Act. 5 Section 4. Subsection 1.(g) A.c.5 of Public Law 13-149 is hereby amended as follows: 6 7 "A. Department of Parks and Recreation 8 Recreation Division 5. For Equipment, not 0 to exceed 10 \$10,126 The monies realised by the reduction in this Section 11 are reverted back to the General Fund to finance the appro-12 13 priation in Section 3 of this Act." 14 Section 5. Section 11102.1 of the Government Code 15 (Public Law 14-1) is amended to read: 16 "Section 11102.1. Same: Elected Members. 17 The members of the Board of Education shall be public 18 officers elected from the districts delineated in Section 11102.2 in accordance with Title III of 19 20 this Code, provided that the youth member shall 21 be elected at-large and further provided that, 22 Title III of this Code notwithstanding, candidates 23 for such election shall be nominated only as provided in Section 11102.3; provided that me 24 25 person shall be a candidate for election nor shall 26 sit as a member of the Board of Education who is an 27 employee of the Government of Guan when membership 28 on the Board would be inconsistent with or conflict 29 with said employment because of the relationship 30 of the Board of Education to said employment, 31 employee or the employee's duties. 1 shall include all employees of the Department of 2 Education." 3 Section 6. A new Section 5603 is hereby added to the Government Code to read as follows: "Section 5603. Budget Allocation. There is hereby authorized an annual budget for the Office 6 of the Lieutenant Governor beginning with Piscal 7 Year 1977. This is to insure the effective discharge of the responsibilities and duties of the Office 10 of the Lieutenant Governor as an office separate 11 from that of the Governor pursuant to Section 6 12 of the Organic Act of Guam and Chapter V. Title 13 VI of the Government Code of Guam. Notwithstanding 14 any provision of the law, rule or regulation or 15 executive order to the contrary, the funds allocated 16 shall be administered solely by the Lieutenant 17 Governor of Guam and expended upon his authorization 18 for the purposes of the allocation." 19 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from the 20 General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) 21 for the Guam Conference on Islands and Archipelago Sea Law 22 to be held April, 1977. 23 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from the 24 General Fund the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the purpose of installing an outfield fence at the Sgt. 25 Pedro Pangelinan Memorial Ballpark in Agana Heights. 26 27 Section 9. The belence of Fifteen Thousand Dellars (\$15,000.00) from the sum appropriated by Public Law 13-25 28 for the Pacific Conference of Legislators is hereby reverted 29 30 to the General Fund to finance the appropriation made by 31 Sections 7 and 8 of this Act.

Section 10. A new Chapter III is added to Title VI of the Government Code to read:

"CHAPTER III

Boards and Commissions

section 5200. No person who has served as a member of the Guam Legislature shall prior to the expiration of two (2) years from the end of the last term in which he stood for reelection in the Legislature be appointed to any Board or Commission (whether heretofore or hereafter created) whose members are appointed by the Governor.

years from the date of an election in which he was a candidate no person who is a candidate for public office shall be eligible for appointment to any Board or Commission (whether heretofore or hereafter created) whose members are appointed by the Governor if such person was a member of such a Board or Commission during the twelve (12) month period immediately preceding such election.

Section 5202. No person whose appointment requires Legislative concurrence shall simultaneously serve on more than one Board or Commission."

Section 11. Section 6 of Public Law 13-179 is hereby repealed.
