




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SPECIAL LEAVE
FOR THOSE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYEES
WHO WERE ELECTED DELEGATES TO THE
CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. An employee of the government of Guam who
3 is elected a delegate to the Constitutional Convention created by
4 Chapter III, Title XVI of the Government Code shall be excused from
5 his normal duties as necessary to participate in said Constitu-
6 tional Convention. Such excuse from duty provided for herein
7 shall not be chargeable to either annual or sick leave. An employee
8 excused from normal duty as provided for herein shall continue to
9 draw his regular pay during such times as he is excused.

10 No employee shall be compensated beyond his normal duty hours
11 during the time that he is a delegate.

12 Section 2. No delegate to the Constitutional Convention
13 created by Chapter III, Title XVI of the Government Code shall be
14 compensated from any monies appropriated for the operation of the
15 Convention.
