

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$3,000 TO ALLOW THE
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM TO AID IN THE COST TO
INSTALL AN ADEQUATE AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM
WITHIN THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION LOCKER ROOMS
IN THE GEORGE WASHINGTON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL
GYM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 STATEMENT OF LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS: The ventilation system
2 in the two physical education locker rooms have been found to be
3 inadequate. On many occasions the temperature in the locker room
4 have been found to be twenty degrees higher than the temperature
5 outside. Reports of faintings, dizziness, and growing weak have
6 been noted due to such high temperatures. The absence of adequate
7 ventilation also causes excess humidity to build up within the
8 room causing clothing to stale and students to sweat more even
9 after they have showered. It would be in the best interest of
10 the government to provide additional funds to air condition the
11 locker rooms for the welfare and health of our school children.
12 The additional \$3,000 is needed to supplement the \$14,000 raised
13 by the students of the George Washington Senior High School.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

15 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General
16 Fund Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) to be used for the in-
17 stallation of an adequate air conditioning system within the
18 physical education locker rooms in the George Washington Senior
19 High School gym.

20 Section 2. Maximum effort will be exerted to complete this
21 project before School Year 1977-1978. Any balance remaining on
22 December 31, 1977 of the appropriation made under Section 1 shall
23 revert to the General Fund.

1 Section 3. Section 1, VI., Item B., of Public Law 10-171
2 Tenth Guam Legislature, as amended by P.L. 11-6 is further amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "B. Park Development \$70,000"

5 Section 4. Public Law 13-182 is hereby repealed in its
6 entirety.
